Professional learning

Foster a whole-school approach to pedagogies

- Collaboratively develop agreed signature practices.
- Collaboratively and consistently embed agreed practices.
- Systematically review or quality assure agreed practices.

Empower students in their learning

- Embed pedagogical practices that build student ownership, including:
 - \circ collaborative goal setting
 - $\circ \ \text{feedback}$
 - $\circ\;$ visible learning.

Cultivate a professional learning culture

- Provide regular opportunities to strengthen staff understanding and implementation of appropriate and effective pedagogical practices.
- Consider using observation, feedback and coaching practices as part of collaborative professional learning.
